

HOW TO CHANGE A LIGHTBULB



STEP 1

Make sure you have all your materials.

1. A new lightbulb of the correct type and wattage.
2. A sturdy step stool or ladder if the light fixture is out of reach.
3. A cloth or gloves (optional, but recommended for safety and cleanliness).



STEP 2

Ensure Safety First:

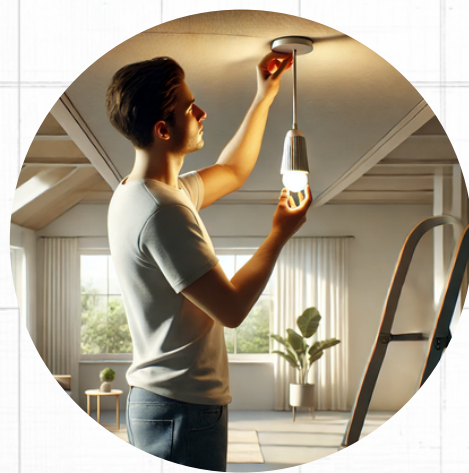
- For lamps, simply unplug the lamp.
- For ceiling fixtures, turn off the light switch.
- If the light was recently on, give it a few minutes to cool down to avoid burns.



STEP 3

Remove the Old Bulb:

1. If the light fixture is high, carefully position your step stool or ladder beneath it.
2. Turn the bulb counterclockwise until it loosens and comes out of the socket.



STEP 4

Install the new bulb:

1. Remove the new bulb from its packaging.
2. Align the base of the new bulb with the socket.
3. Turn the bulb clockwise until it is snugly in place. Be careful not to over-tighten.



5 STEP

Test the New Bulb:

- Plug in the lamp or turn the light switch back on.
- If you turned off the circuit breaker, switch it back on.
- Flip the switch to ensure the new bulb works. If it doesn't, double-check that the bulb is properly screwed in and that the power source is functioning.
